FESTIVAL OF TREES

Gather your ornaments, garland and your team of helpers! Come be a part of the inaugural Festival of Trees at Heritage Holidays.

Wolcott Mill Metropark will supply one tree, a tree stand, 200 pre-hung white LED string lights, signage with your company's information and proper environmental disposal of each tree. Pre-registration is required. Space is limited

Participants are asked to decorate their tree using the following guidelines:

- Trees will be available for decorating from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 20 to November 28, 2016. Please plan to have your tree completely decorated by 4 p.m., November 28, 2016. All trees must be decorated on-site at Wolcott Mill Metropark Historic Center. Contact the Wolcott Mill Park Office to let the staff know when you will be on-site to decorate your tree.
- 2. Be creative! We anticipate the decorated trees to be unique to each organization. Decorations can be homemade or purchased, however, will be exposed to winter weather. Be sure they are made of materials that can withstand snow, moisture and wind.
- 3. A 6-7 foot live tree, a tree stand and lights will be provided. We ask that no additional lights be added.
- 4. Tree location will be assigned and will be provided when you receive a confirmation of registration.
- 5. Decorations designed to feed wildlife, or that could harm wildlife, are not allowed. Do not use any food items on your tree.
- 6. Decorations should be tied or wired securely to your tree to resist high winds, rain, snow and vandalism. Standard ornament hangers are not adequate.
- 7. Heritage Holiday guests will vote for their favorite tree throughout the event. The winning tree will be announced on Monday, December 19, 2016.
- 8. Plan to pick up your decorations between December 19 and December 28, 2016. Contact the Wolcott Mill Park Office to let the staff know when you will be on-site to disassemble your decorations. All decorations not picked up by 4 p.m. on December 28, 2016 may be donated.
