- 3. *Vehicle entry fees* Metropark vehicle permits are required on all motor vehicles which enter a Metropark. Park entry fees are not included in the reservation fee.
- 4. Alcohol beer and wine are permitted (no glass bottles) (no hard liquor).
- 5. Damage Permitee will be held financially responsible for damage beyond normal fair wear and tear and will be billed for excess damage and/or clean up.
