



# KENSINGTON METROPARK FISHING REGULATIONS

- State fishing licenses are required of all persons past their 17th birthday. Licenses are not sold in the park but may be obtained at major sporting goods stores.
- Information pertaining to open seasons, size limits and creel limits as established by the Department of Natural Resources are available at [www.michigan.gov/dnr/fishing](http://www.michigan.gov/dnr/fishing).
- Spearing or bow and arrow season for noxious fish is April 1 to August 15. Spear or bow and arrow is not permitted from shore south of Buno Road Memorial Day to August 15.
- Fishing is not permitted in the nature study area except for the southwest end of Wildwing Lake with waders. Fishing is prohibited in or on any boat dock, launching area, bridge, boardwalk or posted area.
- Ice shanties must be marked on all four sides with name and complete address of owner in waterproof letters, at least two inches high. Tents or temporary shelters that are removed from the ice each day do not require identification. All shanties must be removed by March 1 or before ice becomes unsafe.
